PUMP OUT SERVICE

The pump out system is mounted permanently on the east dock in front of the clubhouse. It is token operated and available day or night. Tokens are \$15.00 each and can be purchased in front office from Judy or Justin.



POOL AREA:

- You need a code to access the gate to the pool when entering and exiting.
- Please crank down the umbrellas to prevent damage.
- This pool area is not for your pets.
- Please do not bring any type of glass in the pool area. Use plastic cups.

BOAT REMOVAL

When boats are removed from the water for the winter, all dock boxes, BBQ's, bicycles and picnic tables are to be removed and stored across from the ramp under the trees or behind the hedges across from Well #10. All patio stones must be picked up by September 23rd and stacked beside the break wall and not more than two stones wide. Any items not removed will be stored at the owner's expense.



Air Conditioners

A friendly reminder that all air conditioners should be turned off when you are not on your boat. Thank you.

Please Note: NO shrink wrapping will be allowed by outside Contractors or boat owners. All shrink wrapping must be contracted to Faiez Shamoon through our Office.

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING DATES:

- ❖ The water will be turned off at docks on October 1st.
- ❖ The electricity will be shut off November 1st at the dock
- ❖ The pool will be closed September 15th



Environmental & Safety

Remember to keep our marina clean by using environmentally friendly products. Clean Marine has rated Holiday Harbour with *5 Anchors*. Please do not discharge OIL or waste of any kind into marina waters. Please use the scrap oil barrel provided.

Float Plan

Please leave a float plan with the marina should you be away for more than 24 hours. It is the safe thing to do. Float Plans should include:

- Date of departure & return
- Port destination if known

US Boaters

Canada Customs requires all US boats be removed from the water by October 31st. An E-99 Form must be completed in full. Please see our staff for assistance in completing the forms.
