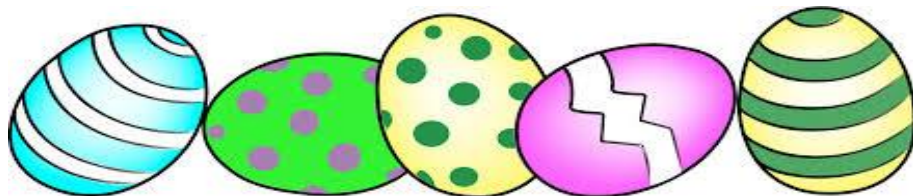

**Summer Dock Fees**

**PLEASE NOTE: SUMMER DOCKAGE PRICING WILL BE THE SAME THIS YEAR.**

50% down payment was due February 16<sup>th</sup>, 2018 to secure your well. The remaining balance to be paid in full by March 30<sup>th</sup>. Reservations after February 16<sup>th</sup> will require a 50% down payment with reservation and the balance due March 16<sup>th</sup>. 2% monthly service charge on overdue accounts.

**Summer Dock Reservations 2018**

- 1<sup>st</sup> Priority** – Year round Members (those who summer dock & winter store with us)
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Priority** – Members who summer dock with us.
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> Priority** – Open – 1<sup>st</sup> come, 1<sup>st</sup> serve starting February 26<sup>th</sup>, 2018
- \*Proof of insurance required with final payment.

**PLEASE BOOK YOUR LAUNCH 3 DAYS MINIMUM AHEAD OF WHEN YOU WOULD LIKE YOUR BOAT LAUNCHED.**

Please remember your boat **MUST** be ready for launch by **May 16<sup>th</sup>!** (Daily dry land storage charge after launch deadline will be \$10/day) U.S Boaters are required by Canada Customs to have their boats in the water by **May 16<sup>th</sup>.**

**Pump Out Service**

The new pump out system is mounted permanently on the east dock in front of the kitchen. It is token operated and available anytime day or night during the week. Tokens will be \$15.00 each and available at the front office.

**Shrink Wrap**

Please bundle your shrink wrap when you take it off your boat, tie it securely, and leave it adjacent to the garbage dumpster. We will take care of the removal & disposal.

**Service**

We invite you to take advantage of the services Holiday Harbour provides. Please book early – we anticipate we will be very busy this spring and we want to make sure all our Members are well taken care of.

**KNOW THE RULES**

**PLEASE NOTE:**

**SPEED** - We have had complaints of speeding in the past. Please slow down for your safety as well as others.

**GARBAGE** - Please do not put garbage bags in the Port-A-Johns. There are appropriate dumpsters for garbage and recycling by the exit gate.

**GATE** - We have heard that members have let their guests through the gate in the past. This is strictly prohibited. All guests have to park outside the gate.

**RAMP** - The ramp is for Holiday Harbour business only. It is not open for the public or any outside contractors. Please consider it a working dock and is not available to anyone.

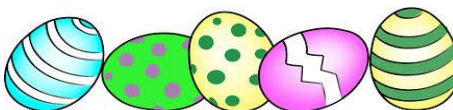
**PETS** - Please clean up after your pets and please make sure your pets are on a leash at all times. Thank you!

**Environmental & Safety**



Remember to keep our marina clean by using environmentally friendly products. Clean Marine has rated Holiday Harbour with \*5 Anchors\*. Please do not discharge **OIL** or waste of any kind into marina waters. Please use the scrap oil barrel provided.

**Float Plan**

Please leave a float plan with the marina should you be away for more than 24 hours. It is the safe thing to do. Float Plans should include:

- date of departure & return
- port destination if known

**Boating Safety**

Now is the time to check over your boat to ensure you have all the necessities for safe boating.

**US Boaters**

Canada Customs requires all US boats be removed from the water by October 31<sup>st</sup>. An E-99 Form must be completed in full. Please see our staff for assistance in completing the forms.

**Air Conditioners**

A friendly reminder that all air conditioners should be turned off when you are not on your boat. Thank you.
