### RULES, REGULATIONS & VARIOUS INFORMATION

#### BOOKING/DEPOSITS: Requirements:

1. All group dockage requires a 50% deposit when booking. The balance may be paid upon arrival at the Marina.

2. We will require the name, address and telephone number of the boater, name of the boat; its numbers, length and width. Once again, we will do whatever we can but cannot guaranty requested wells

Fleet Captains can let us know of how many members they are expecting to be attending and we can fax copies of the Transient Slips and your Fleet Captain can fill in the information; collect the funds and forward.

#### ELECTRICITY:

Please conserve energy. This is especially important when large groups of boaters are in with a group. This puts a great strain on the power supply and leads to outages.

We would ask you to cut down on unessential usage. Please keep in mind, that even the smallest appliances etc., when in a large group, takes a great toll on the electrical power supply.

#### POOL RULES & REGULATIONS:

The pool is salt water and is available for your enjoyment. It is open from 9:00 am until 9:00 pm.

The pool is an unsupervised pool and therefore any bathers under 12 years of age are not permitted unless they are accompanied by an adult or someone 16 years of age or older.

No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.

Maximum number of bathers in the pool at one time is ten and boisterous play in or about the pool is prohibited. Masks and floating devices should not be used.

There is an emergency telephone located in the lobby of the Clubhouse and a First Aid Kit is available in the Office of the Clubhouse.

Persons infected with communicable diseases or having open sores on his or her body shall not enter the pool.

#### CLUBHOUSE WASHROOMS AND

SHOWERS: The Clubhouse is equipped with showers and washrooms for your use. We only ask for cooperation in keeping them clean.

RECYCLING: There are recycling bins located at the southeast corner of the Marina adjacent to the entry gate.

ICE: Located to the left from the Clubhouse. We sell ice by the bag.
